Linda Brown performs extensively as a solo and chamber music artist throughout the eastern United States. Her numerous performances include the North Carolina Composers Symposium, a United States premier performance at the National Building Museum in Washington, D.C., two New York city performances at St. Bartholomew Church, the World's Fair, the National Convocation of The Fellowship of United Methodists, the American Harp Society's Annual Conference and the National Flute Convention.

A graduate of East Carolina University and former flute instructor at St. Andrew Presbyterian College, Mrs. Brown has performed as soloists and principal flutist in numerous symphonies in the Carolinas. She has done extensive work in symphonic, church, and theater settings and has performed for colleges, universities, and community concerts as well as presented residencies.

Mrs. Brown is past president and a charter member of Piedmont Artists, Inc. and has performed twelve concerts on the Piedmont Artists Concert Series. She has performed with such renowned artists as soprano, Sung Sook Lee, tenor, Anthony Dean Griffey, organist/composer Diane Bish, and with Vincent Persichetti at the Seminar in Contemporary Music. Her performances have been broadcast on WFDD, WUNC, and WDAV.
